PUTNAM COUNTY, TN – Property Theft Turns Into Aggravated Assault

Location: Residence in Boiling Springs (south of Cookeville)
Date: Thursday, 4/16/2015
Time: 4:00 pm

A white male in Boiling Springs was assaulted in his front yard on Thursday afternoon, April 16, 2015, by a man and woman trying to steal his chainsaw. At approximately 4:00 p.m., the homeowner saw the subjects trying to steal the chainsaw and tried to stop the theft. At that point the male subject stabbed the homeowner lacerating his hands and arms. The subjects fled the scene in a vehicle.

Sergeant Josh Reams and deputies from the Sheriff's Office Warrants Division apprehended the subjects on Friday morning at approximately 11:30 a.m. in front of a trailer located on 8680 Waterplant Road in Baxter.

The subjects are:

Donald Ray Goney, age 33, charged with Aggravated Assault and Attempted Aggravated Robbery. Bond is \$27,500.

Amanda Ramirez, age 29, charged with Attempted Aggravated Robbery. Bond is set at \$20,000. Ramirez also had a General Sessions Capias for failure to appear or pay with bond at \$1,000.
