PUTNAM COUNTY, TN – Wanted Subject Captured En Route to SuperBowl Event

On their way to a SuperBowl event Sunday night, Sergeant Josh Reams and Major Greg Whittaker of the Putnam County Sheriff's Office spotted Brandi Cline, a female subject wanted for Violation of Probation on Felony Charges, at a Silver Point gas station convenience store. Reams had been searching for her the previous day with deputies Jeremy Nash and Bryan Whitefield of the Sheriff's Office Warrants Unit. He quickly identified the subject and the friend who was waiting for her in a white Dodge Neon. The friend, Tradonna Horn, fled the scene and was later arrested at home.

"We are never off duty," stated Sgt. Reams, who serves on the U.S. Marshal's Fugitive Task Force in addition to his full time job with the Sheriff's Office. "We had been searching for the subject the previous day and had informed her friends that once they were advised that Ms. Cline was a wanted subject, they could be charged with Accessory After The Fact if they continued to help her evade arrest."

Dressed in blue jeans and in his personal car, Reams went into the store, showed the subject his credentials and made the arrest. As he walked her outside, the subject's sister drove up in a white minivan started screaming at the deputies. Taking advantage of the distraction, Ms. Cline broke free and took off on foot. After a short pursuit, Reams and Whittaker captured the subject and placed her in a hold on the ground until transport arrived to take her to the Putnam County Jail.

A third party, the other friend who helped Ms. Cline evade arrest, was located and taken into custody by Deputy Jeremy Nash. All three women are now booked into Putnam County Jail on the following charges:

Brandi Cline – 24, resident of 222 N. Walnut Avenue, Apt. 2, Cookeville, TN, was arrested on charges of Violation of Probation on Felony Charges and Evading Arrest and is being held in Putnam County Jail on \$1500 bond.

Daphnie Tudor – 22, resident of 222 N. Walnut Avenue, Apt 2, Cookeville, TN, was arrested on a charge of Resisting Arrest and booked into Putnam County Jail.

Tradonna Horn – 18, resident of 217 Sewell Street, Baxter, TN, was arrested on charges of Driving on a Revoked Suspended License and Accessory After The Fact and booked into Putnam County Jail on \$1000 bond for the first charge and \$2500 bond for the second charge.
