AGGRAVATED BURGLARY SUBJECT ARRESTED

PUTNAM COUNTY, TN – On Tuesday, July 26, 2016, the Putnam County Sheriff's Office received a call from a woman stating that a man was breaking into her residence on Shipley Road in Putnam County. Sgt. Nash and Deputy DJ Sons responded. While en-route they were advised by Dispatch that the subject had kicked in the door and was walking through the residence. Putnam County Sheriff's Department Communications Deputy Charlotte Clayburn kept the victim on the phone and tried to keep her calm so that the subject would not hear her. Shortly before Sgt. Nash and Deputy Sons arrived, the subject was standing outside of the bathroom that the victim was hiding in. Sgt. Nash and Deputy Sons immediately entered the residence upon arrival and found Joshua Kane Love trying to flee the residence through the back door. Love, a 35-year old Cookeville resident, was taken into custody inside the residence and charged with Aggravated Burglary.

Love has an extensive criminal history, including domestic assault, violation of protection order, stalking, criminal trespassing, assault, forgery, aggravated assault, introducing drugs into a county institution, vandalism, and aggravated burglary.
